


THE PROBLEM

80% of all stolen bikes have locks attached to them when stolen


It is the opportunist thief, seeking to supplement their weekly income, who incur the majority of thefts

CLAMP - IT




A unit and business model that:

The Clamp-IT Lock














Our Market

5 market segments

- 28 train operators manage 2563 passenger railway stations, carrying 2.7 million daily train commuters
